- 6. Work with inventory specialist to create and maintain a system for tracking inventory needs and identifying vehicles to purchase.
- 7. Continually look for buying opportunities and keep a detailed list of leads.
- 8. Perform other duties as needed. These may include cross training in other departments, meetings, attending trade shows, and delivery or pickup of vehicles.
- 9. Suggest improved methods and practices for the business operations when experience and common-sense dictates.
